

## **Centerville Independent School District Community and Student Engagement**

### **Overview**

House Bill 5 (HB 5) of the 83rd Texas Legislature Regular Session added Section 39.0545 to the Texas Education Code (TEC). TEC § 39.0545 requires that each school district assign ratings of Exemplary, Recognized, Acceptable, Unacceptable or Not Applicable for the district and for each campus on both overall performance and each of nine factors related to community and student engagement. The nine Factors are: fine arts, wellness and physical education, community and parental involvement, 21st Century Workforce Development programs, second language acquisition programs, digital learning environment, dropout prevention strategies, educational programs for gifted and talented students, and compliance with statutory reporting requirements. A rating label of Yes or No is assigned for Factor 9, compliance with statutory reporting requirements.

For the 2017-2018 school year, the three chosen Community and Student Engagement (CASE) components for Centerville Independent School District's academic accountability are:

- Community and Parental Involvement
- Wellness and Physical Ed
- Dropout Prevention Strategies

### **Criteria for House Bill 5: Evaluation of Performance in (CASE)**

#### **Community and Parental Involvement**

Staff, parents, and community members will be encouraged to complete a survey through the CISD website to rate the community and parental involvement.

Survey questions:

- The District provides information on the Centerville ISD website as a good source of information for programs and resources.
- The District has an emergency contact alert system when there is a threat to student safety or changes in the school calendar due to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances.
- The District provides various opportunities for parental involvement, including Parent Night, Meet the Teacher Night, Christmas Program, Field Day, GT Night, Academic/Athletic Banquet, FFA Recognition, Awards Assemblies, Homecoming, Fall Carnival, Graduation, etc.
- The Parent Portal grade book allows access to student grades, is easy to use, and a source of good information about student progress.

#### **Wellness and Physical Ed:**

Staff, parents, and community members will be encouraged to complete a survey through the CISD website to rate the Wellness and Physical Ed.

Survey questions:

- The District provides at least three community education programs related to wellness and physical education, such as Obesity Awareness Week, Healthy at H.E.B. Community Challenge, Healthy Texas Week, Marathon Kids, Volleyball Play day (red ribbon week), CISD Field Day, Health Fairs, etc.
- The District provides a safe and Bully Free Zone.

### **Dropout Prevention Strategies:**

Staff, parents, and community members will be encouraged to complete a survey through the CISD website to rate the Dropout Prevention Strategies.

Survey questions:

- The District provides opportunities to create an emotionally healthy, inclusive environment by offering activities such as Bully prevention education, Social and Emotional Learning (SEL), character education, etc.
- The District provides opportunities for credit recovery, such as summer school, zero hour classes, an online credit recovery program, etc.
- Alternative scheduling is offered to help at risk students balance classes with work and extracurricular activities.

The participants will rate the questions from "NA" to "10: with NA=no knowledge and 10 being superior. The CASE evaluation committee takes the responses and assigns them a label of unacceptable (0-3), acceptable (4-5), recognized (6-7), or exemplary (8-10).
